

STONEWALL PEACH QUEEN AND COURT APPLICATION AND REQUIREMENTS

Requirements:

You must be a junior or senior girl enrolled in a Gillespie County High School for the 2008-2009 school year.

You must not be married or have ever been married.

You must not have a child or have ever had a child.

You and your parents/guardians must have resided in Gillespie County for at least one year.

You must be a student of good standing and maintain a minimum grade average of 75 for the year.

You must not have been charged with any misdemeanor (excluding minor traffic violations) or felony.

If chosen:

You must reside with your parents/legal guardians during the year of your reign.

You will be required to ride the float in various parades around the Hill Country. If you miss more than 3 parades (without consent from the board) you will be asked to resign and forfeit your title, crown, and scholarship. A dress to be worn on the float will be provided to you by the Stonewall Chamber of Commerce.

You will be asked to resign and forfeit your title, crown, and scholarship if you become pregnant or get married during the year of reign.

If you are not able to complete the year of reign, you agree that you will forfeit your title, crown, and scholarship.

Scholarships must be utilized within 24 months of the end of reign. Proof of enrollment (registration, receipts, etc.) must be provided to the Stonewall Chamber of Commerce. Scholarship checks will be made payable to you and the college.

You must remain in school during the year of reign. If you drop out of school you will be asked to resign and forfeit your title, crown, and scholarship. Home schooling will be considered on a case by case basis and is subject to vote by the Stonewall Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors.

You must not enter any contests or activities that may interfere with your year of reign. (i.e., Fair Queen, Farm Bureau court, etc)

While you are wearing your sash and crown, you are representing the Stonewall Chamber of Commerce, the Stonewall Peach JAMBoree, and the peach industry, therefore; the following behavior will NOT BE TOLERATED:

- 1) Minor in Possession-If you are charged with a MIP (regardless of the circumstances) at ANY TIME during the year of reign you will be required to resign and forfeit your title, crown, and scholarship.

- 2) Foul language, rude behavior, disrespect to other organizations, and/or consumption of drugs or alcohol while representing the Stonewall Chamber of Commerce, the Stonewall Peach JAMBoree, and the Community of Stonewall is just cause for immediate mandatory resignation. You will be required to resign and forfeit your title, crown, and scholarship.
